





## Get started!

- Remove the growing container and add four full pipettes of nutrients into the water tank.
- 2 Fill the water tank with tap water.



- Fill the growing container with growing medium until it reaches the watering ring. (don't fill it above the watering ring)
  - Rinse the dust from the growing medium by pouring tap water in the growing container. Let the water drain from the bottom down into a sink. (this only needs to be done when using the growing medium for the first time)





- Put the growing container back on the water tank.

  Make sure it is positioned right and that the growing container is not tilted.
- Plant seeds in the growing container and make sure they are covered by the growing medium.
- Connect the adapter to an electrical outlet. Botanium will then water the medium every 3rd hour.

You have now become an urban gardener!



## Maintenance

- Refill the tank when the water level gets low. Make sure to always add nutrients (4 full pipettes/1 full water tank) to the water when refilling.
- Every other month, pour out all of the old water and rinse the inside of the water tank.
- If the roots grow past the bottom of the grow container, cut or pull off the root parts that extend past the container.
- If you grow tomatoes, chili or any fruiting plant dose 4 full pipettes per full water tank as soon as flowers appear.

## **Tips**

- Put your Botanium in a window with lots of light. If you have less than 10 hours or daylight per day, put it under a lamp. (for more information on what kind of light to use, visit botanium.se/growingguide)
- If you have very hard water where you live, consider using cleaner water from another source.
- ONLY use Botanium nutrients or hydroponic nutrients. Using fertilizers for soil might damage the pump.
- To make the water last longer when you're travelling, remove your Botanium from sun or strong light while you are away.
- Never use soil in your Botanium. The roots will drown and you'll kill the plant. Don't kill plants.
